

T'Sou-ke First Nation Council Oath of Office

I have been duly elected to the Council of T'Sou-ke First Nation, and swear/affirm that:

- 1. I will truly, faithfully, impartially, and to the best of my skill, ability, and knowledge, execute the duties, powers and trusts placed in me as a member of T'Sou-ke Nation Chief and Council.
- 2. I am duly qualified to be an elected member of T'Sou-ke First Nation.
- 3. I have disclosed any and all conflicts of interest or potential conflicts of interest, and that I will immediately divest myself of the same for the duration of my term in office.
- 4. I will uphold and comply with the Chief and Council Code of Ethics, adopted by Chief and Council.
- 5. I acknowledge that I owe fiduciary duties to T'Sou-ke First Nation as a whole to act honestly, in good faith, and in the best interests of T'Sou-ke first Nations at all times, and that I may be personally liable if I fail to discharge these duties.
- 6. I acknowledge that I am expected to serve as a good role model for the community during my term of office, and that malfeasance or Corrupt Practices will not be tolerated.
- 7. I acknowledge my obligations to, and I agree that I will, at all times:
 - a. Keep confidential all confidential matters, records and reports dealt with by Chief and Council, except where Council authorizes disclosure of same;
 - Perform my official duties free from any apparent or actual conflicts of interest, as that term is defined in the Council Code of Ethics Policy;
 - c. Comply with all applicable T'Sou-ke First Nation laws, bylaws and policies; and
 - d. Uphold the principles of openness, accountability, and transparency.
- 8. I agree to offer my resignation if Chief and Council, by resolution, decide that I have broken my Oath of Office.
